The above URL is a full description of our current rule. For the past 3 years, CaYPT has held online national tournament successfully. We have adapted our version of the rules directly from IYPT with some variations. We hold a national tournament every March, while offering as many spots as we can handle for the national camp by selecting the top performing students from our national tournament. Typically, it is between 15 to 20 spots depending on how much help we can get from past participants. Then we select the final 5 based on lab time, test mark, contribution to problems solved and some other criteria.
