





*Brief description of the selection procedure*

A nation-wide physical tournament, Taiwanese Young Physicists' Tournament (TYPT), is held every year about early March. The tournament is carried out in 4 days and consists of 5 full-scale selective Physics Fights and a Final Fight of best teams. A subset of 12 problems, selected from the 17 IYPT problems and announced in August, are used in TYPT.

The tournament is open to all high school students in Taiwan. Each team is formed by 3-5 students either from different schools (independent teams) or the same school (school representative teams) with a condition that each school can send no more than two representative teams. Due to limited capacity of 26 teams of TYPT, registration is prioritized based on registration time with an additional rule that the second school representative teams have lower priority than the first school representative teams.

National team members are selected from outstanding students in TYPT.
