Annex: Brief description of the selection procedure



### *Annex: Brief description of the selection procedure*

All rules and regulations for the Georgian Young Physicists Tournament is nearly the same as on IYPT. Some minor changes are made to ensure selecting the right students for the team.

To form Team of Georgia we start preparation for the local Young Physicists tournament when school begins, usually middle of September. First of all, we translate problems to Georgian, because only Georgian presentations are allowed on the local invent. We publish those problems to our Facebook Page and also send it to every group who is interested participating in the tournament.

Any team from Georgia can participate. Of course There are some rules:

- Teams must have 3 to 5 members;
- Team must have at least one supervisor older than 18 years;
- Team should send application form one month before tournament.

All tams which fulfill those criterions are allowed to the Georgian Young Physicists Tournament. There are 5 selecting and one final fight. In one fight there are 3 or 4 teams in one room. Number of rooms depends on the participating teams. Every team have exactly one Reporter, one Opponent and one reviewer in one fight. Opponent team offers problem to the reporter in the 1-4 fights. In 5-th fight all teams choose problems they want to preset. Jury provides scores for all participation teams. Scoring system is exactly the same as in the IYPT.

Three teams that have highest score plays in the final. In the final all previous scores are nulled, but coefficients for the presentation is kept as it was in the 5\_th fight. Teams choose themselves what problems they will present. After three rounds winner team becomes team with the highest scores.

Jury: In each room there must be at least 6 jury member. In the final fight there are more than 10 members. Georgia has long history of participation IYPT and we have many experienced physicists who are well aware of IYPT regulations and requirements. Currently Jury members are professors from 4 major universities of Georgia. New jury members can also participate in tournament if they fulfill criterions identical as IYPT regulations.

After the tournament jury members have mitting, where they choose candidates for the team of Georgia. All members of winner team automatically are considered as candidates. Jury choses additional 5 or less candidates. Also all participating team leaders can choose one candidate for the team. Team leader who will represent Georgia becomes winner team's leader. One week later Jury and Team leaders listen to the presentation of candidates in English. Jury and Team leaders make joint decision about Team Members, who will participate at IYPT.
