## **Persian Young Physicists' Tournament, PYPT; Iran Team Selection for IYPT/AYPT**

Students from different schools register by filling the [registration form](#) to participate in Persian Young Physicists' Tournament, PYPT, each year. All the information is accessible through AYIMI website ([www.ayimi.org](http://www.ayimi.org)) and all details in Farsi page: <https://ayimi.org/مسابقات-علمي/iypt-pypt> and short explanation in En. <https://ayimi.org/en/scientific-tournaments/iypt-pypt-tournaments>. During October and November students send their abstracts and according to the PYPT regulations they compete in 3 PFs and sometimes in Final 3-4 teams are the gold and silver medalists. Otherwise, we announce the number of gold, silver and bronze medalists according to the scores in total 3 PFs. All the participants are given diploma too. Teams are judged by PYPT independent and team leaders' jurors but the same as IYPT rules they don't judge their own teams.

During the pandemic our tournaments and other scientific and cultural activities have been online and from the last year AYIMI with ADIB Culture and Art Foundation (Authorized by ministry of Culture) cooperation have organized several programs in Iran.

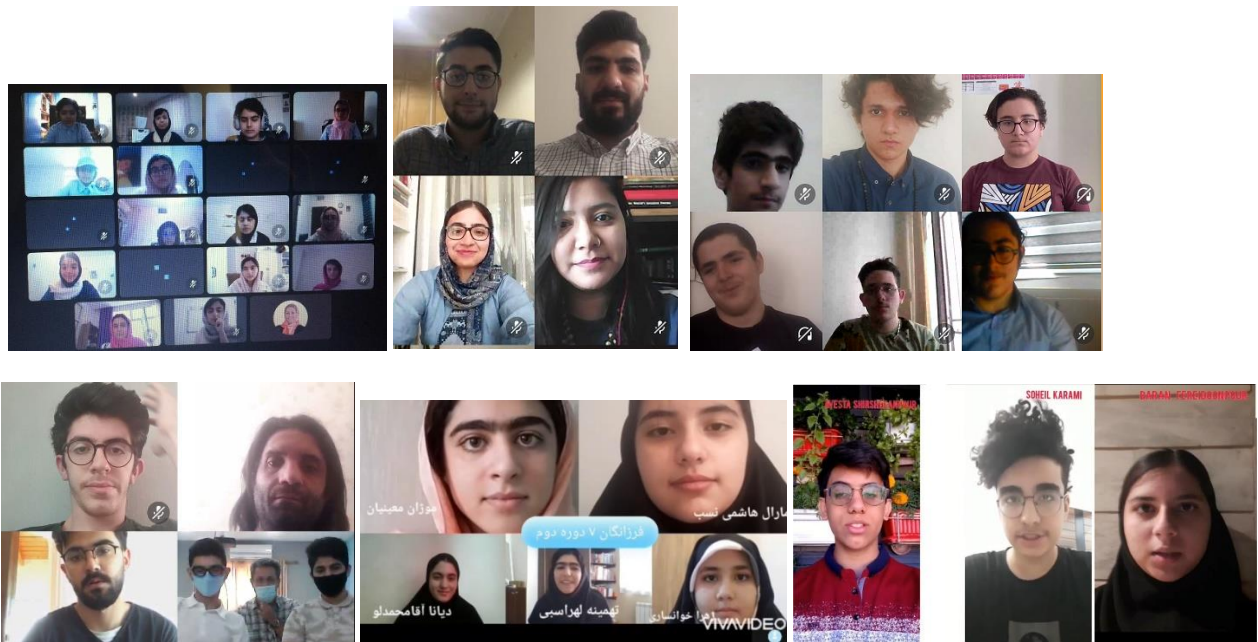
For Online PYPT students are registered in Discord platform and the same as Online IYPT in Georgia they challenge in different groups according to the draw ceremony and the best teams according to the scores are awarded in closing ceremony. Students are asked to send their full research papers to the International Journal of Young Scientist Research (<http://journal.ayimi.org>) which is in different fields. AYIMI guide and help students in writing scientific papers too.

The best students are invited to participate in our educational workshops to make them ready and finalize their problems for international competitions. According to the decisions are made by our scientific committee, PYPT rules will be changed some years to get the best result but it is followed as IYPT regulations (report, discussion and review). Due to the lack of experimental setups most of the experiments are analyzed by very simple devices but we hope in future IUPAP support developing countries in laboratories facilities too.

To avoid misunderstanding of the main idea related to each IYPT problems, from 2022 (2<sup>nd</sup> online PYPT) students who have registered in [online PYPT](#) are asked to participate in our online workshops to discuss about the problems who are directed by several team leaders in each group. Then during exact time (end of February) in two days they challenge with each other.

After publishing IYPT 2012 proceeding book and PYPT book in 2014, now we are working on another book in IYPT/ IYNT.
