

## **Call for Participation**

In early September, an open invitation is being sent to all schools and students, for them to participate in the selection procedure of Greece's IYPT team.

## **Team Formation**

Students who expressed their interest to participate are asked to form teams of three. Each participating team has one or more Team Leaders, responsible for the team's preparation.

## **Team Support**

The Hellenic Physical Society organizes weekly on-line meetings, starting in October, in which the rules, the procedures as well as the roles of the tournament are explained. There is also a brief analysis of the problems and any kind of help is provided to all teams and Team Leaders equally.

## **Selection of the national team**

In late February, the Hellenic Physical Society organizes a National Tournament, called HellenicYPT. Every team participates in 3 Physics Fights, where every student performs each role once. After the end of this tournament, the five (5) top students, with the highest total score, form the Hellenic national team which will represent Greece at the official IYPT.

## **Training of the national team**

In the following months, the students of the national team are trained all together until the official IYPT.
