

Annex: Brief description of the selection procedure

The aim of the competition is to promote and enhance the scientific and technological skills and potential of students by providing them with opportunities to engage, grow, and excel in physics and its applications. Furthermore, the competition's format encourages innovation, autonomy, and the ability to work in a group. The objectives of the competition align with the actions promoted by the Ministry of Education and Merit to emphasize the teaching of scientific disciplines, supporting teacher training, fostering encounters between young individuals and science through hands-on teaching as a concrete and effective tool to motivate students to study.

The competition is open to female and male students enrolled in state or private secondary schools, as well as Italian schools abroad, without distinction of nationality and citizenship, attending the second-to-last and final year.

The students interested in participating can submit their application following the instructions provided below:

1. Submit the participation application for the competition electronically using the dedicated form available online and accessible from the competition's website (www.iyptitalia.it). It is recommended to submit the form as soon as possible to get in touch with the competition staff.
2. Send the completed design sheet for the solution to one of the problems proposed by the international committee (as outlined in the following Article 4) to the email address iyptitalia@scienzaescuola.eu, no later than 23:59 on January 31, 2024. Please note that there is an extension beyond the initially scheduled submission date of January 7, 2024.
3. Submit the presentation of the solution to one of the problems proposed by the international committee, as outlined in Article 6, to the email address iyptitalia@scienzaescuola.eu, no later than 23:59 on February 12, 2024. There is an extension granted beyond the initially scheduled submission date of January 31, 2024.

The selection process will unfold in two phases. The first phase will take place online and will assess the design of the solution and the presentation of the solution based on the evaluation tables available at the following link on the [IYPT Italia website](http://www.iyptitalia.it). Ten candidates will be selected to advance to the second phase, and the list of those selected will be published on February 22, 2024, on the IYPT Italia website and communicated directly to the chosen students.

The second phase will consist of an in-person interview in which candidates will present their solutions. The date and location of the interview will be published later on the IYPT Italia website (www.iyptitalia.it) and officially communicated to the finalist students. At the end of the second phase, 5 candidates (plus 2 reserves) will be selected to represent Italy in Budapest for IYPT 2024. This second phase, involving the selection of the Italian team, will conclude by the first half of March.
