



Annex: Brief description of the selection procedure

Preliminary Selection Process:

Given the anticipated high level of interest, an initial round will be conducted where students will be invited to submit a presentation showcasing their progress on the assigned problems, completed by December (following the release of the problems). A rigorous evaluation of these submissions will determine a select group of up to fifteen students who will advance to the final stage of the competition.

Final Competition and Team Selection:

The final competition, a selective event tentatively scheduled for February, will assess both individual and team performance. A distinguished panel of judges will carefully evaluate the participants, ultimately selecting the members of the National Team for the prestigious International Young Physicists Tournament. In addition, two team leaders for the current year will be chosen.

Appointment of IOC Representative:

One of the selected team leaders will be nominated as the representative to the International Organizing Committee (IOC). Any subsequent changes in team leadership or IOC representation will be communicated promptly through official channels.

We are confident that this comprehensive selection process will identify the most promising young physicists, ensuring exceptional representation for our nation at the International Young Physicists Tournament.
