

Kazakh National IYPT is called 'KZ IYPT'

The registration period begins in September, when the regulation and problems are published and translated. Usually there are around more than 20 teams from private and state schools.

Teams are required to submit a technical report with the proposed solution for 7 problems until December. After it there are choose the teams which qualified to participate at the KZ IYPT in January.

KZ IYPT will be organized for 3-4 days at the end of March or in the beginning of April, approximately.

1st day: Registration, Opening ceremony, Jury Meeting

2nd day: Fights, Jury Meetings

3rd and 4th days: Fights, Jury Meetings Final Ceremony

The Kazakh National team is then composed of 1 student from each of the top 5 teams in KZ IYPT.
